It is extremely important that all nominees and their CEO or immediate supervisor understand the time and attendance commitment they will make to this program. THERE ARE STRICT MANDATORY ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION POLICIES TO WHICH THE PARTICIPANT MUST ADHERE in order to graduate from the program. These policies are in place to protect the integrity of the program.

The Leadership program will begin in August with a mandatory kick-off program, Thursday afternoon and Friday, all day. Leadership Sylacauga will meet for daylong sessions on the fourth Thursday of each month from September through May.

In order to graduate from Leadership Sylacauga, each participant must attend at least 75 hours of the scheduled 80-hour program.

Cellular telephones should not be used during class time. In the event of an emergency, the Chamber staff will be able to reach participants to notify them of the situation.

The 2010 tuition for Leadership Sylacauga is \$350.00, which may be paid by either the participant or the sponsoring organization. This fee will cover all costs associated with conducting the nine-month program. Additionally, a \$10.00 non-refundable application fee should be submitted with your application. Please advise the Chamber staff regarding procedures for invoicing your employer. Installment payments may be allowed, with approval of the committee.
